


Classes resume this Saturday January 4th. For this Nutcracker rehearsal – please arrive in their Ballet costume. Rehearsal will run from 9:30am til about 12:30. Our youngest Saturday morning 3–4 yr old classes may go as soon as they are finished. Bring your tap shoes if you're in a combo class. You can drop and go parents, no need to stay for older dancers.

Show Day Details!

Dancers need to be there 15 mins before doors. This is a 30 min drive north from the studio so plan accordingly.

Doors open at 11:30 and 2:30pm.

On show day, please have your performer arrive with stage makeup on and hair in a neat low ponytail. (Nutcracker dancers will need a low bun at Intermission). We will show you to your dressing rooms when you arrive. Younger dancers go to the classrooms to the left of the lobby. Performers ages 12+ will go to the right. Parent volunteers and staff will be backstage to help your child if needed. Please stay in your dressing rooms as much as possible so all of our performers are together and we don't have to hunt them down. Quick changes will have partitions backstage. Performers aged 3-4 may sit with their parents in the audience for free, just bring them backstage 2 numbers before they go on.

Don't forget to pack healthy mess free snacks and water for your performer.

If you're in both shows, we recommend packing food for in between shows.

Please wait in the lobby at the theater after you drop off your child in their dressing rooms for official door times, thank you.

There will be discounted MZ merch and Concessions for sale in the lobby.

Show Tickets

GA (General Admission) seating is first come first serve.

Tickets are available at the front desk until the 10th. Presale Tickets at the studio are \$20. They will also be available at doors for \$25. Children under 3 are free

Cash is best but we accept checks, venmo, zelle, paypal, CC or charge your account at the studio.

Credit card or cash please at the theater.

If you are in both shows a set of 2 tickets will be discounted to \$15 each for the 2nd show. Just let us know at the front desk as you purchase them. These discounted tickets are only available presale at the front desk.

Please invite as many people as you can, the students love a big audience to perform for!

We will be having our 50/50 raffle at both shows, so bring cash for that.

We also will be holding a raffle for the 4 front row center seats to be reserved in your name! Both shows will be offered for this deal. Once you purchase your general admission tickets you may purchase a raffle ticket at the front desk for \$2 each. Be sure to write your name on it to enter the contest. Dress Rehearsal

We will be having a mandatory Full Dress Rehearsal with costumes, hair and full makeup for running the shows on Friday January 10th from 4:00pm to approx. 8:30pm in Studio A. (I did move it 30 mins earlier) All performers must be at dress rehearsal or they are not allowed to perform in the show. Always communicate questions via email-mzdancecompany@gmail.com

*I will attach the call times for your dancer on the last page of this newsletter with the rehearsal line-up so you do not need to stay the whole time.

*We will need one parent of our 3-4 year old's to stay with your child until they are dismissed. Studio B will be open to change costumes. (Moms in there only please) Parents of older capable students need to drop off their kids and go. It gets way too crowded in our tiny lobby. We've got your kiddos!

Costumes and Makeup

Please be sure you have all your costumes pieces, shoes and tights if needed. Write your name on the inside and on tags of all costume pieces and shoes. Costume details are listed under the "MZnewz" page of our website mzdancecompany.com.

Everyone's hair needs to be in a low ponytail, even the boys with long hair. Short hairstyles need the front pulled back in some sort of way away from their face.

Miss Miranda filmed and uploaded a stage makeup tutorial to YouTube for your convenience. We need all of our performers to be seen under the stage lights and look uniform. (It's the silver glitter one from June) Here is the link. <u>https://youtu.be/Boe3wbSouiY?si=0pxdnPMXNg5cCHs_</u>

All performers and especially Aerialists must have this transfer proof lipstick on, or aerialists they will not be permitted on the WHITE equipment. I'm sure you can understand why. Here's an Amazon link to the lipstick-

Additional Reminders!

Everyone needs to stay till the end of the performance to show support to all the other dancers. This is very important and not fair to the dancers at the end of the shows.

Do not stand up and walk through the auditorium while someone is performing. Always wait until a break in between. Let's show good theater etiquette (as this is considered very rude.)

Please note!

You can add additional classes to your schedule after the show if there is space available. Please continue to commit to the classes you signed up for in August. We're not finished with the season as we don't offer semester enrollment at MZ. Our teachers depend on the current schedule.
