6 Week Summer Session

The current Dance season is coming to a close. Our last night of classes will be Thursday June 5th.

You may style your child's hair and makeup however you wish. There's no upfront cost to you. Only pay for the ones you want! We can even do Aerial silks, Trapeze or Hoop photos. The Sign up sheet for a timeslot will be on a clipboard in the lobby the week leading up to it.

We will be having students practice their numbers in costume in the studio the week of May 19th. Just bring your costume, tights, shoes and hair pieces to your classes. This way we can go over any questions.

Story Ballet Rehearsals

There are 2 Saturday Story Ballet Rehearsals. One is May 24th and the other is on May 31st. We require ALL Ballet students including the Monday Ballet classes to be there. For the May 24th rehearsal please arrive at the studio in pink tights and a black leotard with their hair in a neat bun. For the May 31st rehearsal, please come in their Ballet costume. Rehearsal will run from 10am til noon. Our youngest Saturday morning 3-4 yr old classes may go as soon as they are finished. Older teen dancers and leads I'm sure will need to stay a bit later so keep an open mind and thank you for being flexible. Team will also be running their numbers at the end around noon







Mandatory Dress rehearsal

Your mandatory Dress rehearsal is Friday June 6th from 5:00 to approx. 9 p.m. at the Calvary Chapel Worship Center – 6825 Trouble Creek Rd, New Port Richey, FL 34653 (about a 30 min drive from the studio). Please arrive at 4:30 with all of your costumes, accessories, tights. Shoes, water, non messy snacks (pretzels. Animal crackers, fruit snacks) with full stage makeup already on and ready to go. You may drop off your older students. Younger students may have ONE parent accompany them. (They may watch Dress Rehearsal when they are not changing costumes.) We will run the finale/curtain call first with EVERYONE and the Hula babies first so that when your child is finished, they may go. We only run dances one time in order so it will not take as long as the actual shows. Please leave the theater cleaner than how you found it.

I will email the dress rehearsal lineup order soon!

Hair for the girls will need to be in a Ballet Bun unless otherwise instructed. Boys need to have their hair pulled back off the face or in a ponytail if long enough. Hair pieces are in the back zipper pocket of your garment bags and go on the left side of their bun or front of their bun depending on the costume. All performers except Acro students, need tan or ballet pink (for ballet dancers) transition dance tights for their dances. No underwear, jewelry, colored nail polish, or colored bras. Only nude toned Undergarments that don't show please if absolutely needed. Check with your teacher if you're unsure of tights. Shoes or hair pieces. Please come to the theater ready to go with full hair, and makeup already applied. Bring your makeup with you for touch ups.

I need adult volunteers for help in the dressing rooms and Front Lobby. Email Miranda if interested.

We'll be doing the same stage makeup as the last spring recital. This is the silver glitter eyeshadow look with the Maybelline super stay matte ink lipstick in #340 exhilarator. (Any silver glitter eyeshadow will do) Aerialist must wear this lipstick or you will not be permitted on the equipment. If you are new-Tap the link for last years YouTube tutorial to find out what you need and how to apply it. Stage Makeup is absolutely mandatory for Dress rehearsal and the Show.

Day of Show Details

On show day Saturday June 7th, you may arrive with your child at 11:00 for the first show, and 2:00 for the second show. The performers will go to their dressing rooms. All audience members will wait in the large front lobby until doors open at 11:30 and 2:30 where you can purchase additional tickets, merchandise and concessions. You can not save seats in between shows. Everyone will need to clear out to the lobby. Our performance run times will be approximately 2 hours each.

We will have MZ Dance T-Shirts on sale for \$8. New limited edition MZ Dance pink Recital Teddy Bear keepsakes for \$12. Our older bears will be on sale for \$8.

Back by popular demand- We will be offering single or triple flower bouquets for your convenience! We also will have our 50/50 raffle so bring cash for raffle tickets.

Please note- If your child is 3-4 years old, they may sit with you in the audience at the shows (at no cost) Just have them come dressed and ready to perform and take them back stage two numbers before they are supposed to go on. Hula babies can change in the preschool class-rooms left of the lobby after the Story Ballet before returning to their seats.

We suggest if you're child is in both shows to pack a cooler lunch for in between shows for convenience.

Reminder- Do not stand and walk around in the auditorium while dancers and aerialists are performing. Please tell this to your guests as well. You need to wait until a break between numbers to excuse yourself unless it's an emergency. Also NO PERFORMER IS ALLOWED TO LEAVE UNTIL THEIR SHOW IS OVER. We need everyone for the finale bow and awards at the end. The performers near the end of the show deserve a full audience for all their hard work as well. Thank you for being a supportive dance family for everyone's kiddos
